- The Ed Run Memorial Excellence in Education Award -- The 2025 Ed Rund Award was given to WB Brad Phelps of the Jurisdiction of Minnesota for his outstanding work creating and promoting Masonic Education in Minnesota.
- 7. An announcement regarding the 2026 MCME Conference to be held in Omaha, Nebraska, was made to the attendees.
